## New Web Site Teaches Tzedakah

A nonprofit Web site launched in November by Jewish Causes for Choice, called [jchoice.org](http://jchoice.org), will serve as a tool to engage and inspire Jewish adolescents to learn and think about Tzedakah.

[JChoice.org](http://jchoice.org) uses social networking tools to allow bar and bat mitzvah aged kids to give to charities in a safe environment. According to the

site, kids can learn, share ideas and champion the causes that speak to them.

There are four sections on the site. The first component allows users to search for and sort causes by categories like values and geography. Give Now lets users donate directly to charity, give to a friend or family member's account or purchase

gift cards. My [JChoice](http://jchoice.org) Network allows users to interact with their causes. JMix houses other areas of inspiration, including music, video and arts.

Finally, a gift registry for bar and bat mitzvahs allows them and their friends and family to give to a cause.
